EDGWARE ACTIVITY PERIODS - EAP 2010

Celebrate the autumn evenings with some multi-band HF activity in EAP with both CW and SSB action from Tuesday, 21st September to Friday, 1st October. Format and rules remain as last year with some clarification to the rules (we hope). In addition to individual club members participation by club stations is encouraged to provide additional bonus points.

The Edgware Club station, GX3ASR, will be operated once more by G3SJE and other club stations should identify themselves by use of the GX prefix

All logs together with suggestions for rule changes are very welcome and it is possible to enter logs by e-mail if you wish as detailed below.

Sections: A) CW - best 5 bands out of 6. B) SSB - best 5 bands out of 6. C) OVERALL - A) + B) combined

Note: The overall score can draw from all 6 bands if a different "5 bands" are submitted for SSB from CW. The best 5 bands on CW need not be the same as the best 5 bands on SSB. To assist in checking please submit logs for bands not relied on.

Call: CW - "CQ EAP", SSB - "CQ Edgware Activity Period"

Contacts: A station may be contacted once only in each period, but the CW and SSB sections on each band count as separate periods

Exchange: RS(T) plus three figure serial number starting 001 and increasing by 1 for each contact throughout EAP. The serial number continues from one period to the next. Also members and club stations of the listed clubs will send an identifying two letter code after the serial number as shown below. For example a Harrow member might send 599 014 HW.

Axe Vale - AX, Chesham - CM, Coulsdon - CD, Dacorum - DC, Edgware - EW, Harrow - HW, Havering - HG, Hoddesdon - HD, Silverthorne - SL, Southgate - SG, Stevenage - SV, Torbay - TB, Verulam - VQ.

Scoring

Contact points: 20 points per contact with a member of a listed club giving club code. 50 points per contact with GX3ASR. 35 points per contact with a club station of a listed club identified by use of the GX (etc.) prefix (plus club code). Otherwise the club station counts as a club member for 20 points. 5 points for each other contact.

Bonus points: 10 bonus points for each of the first two stations of a club member or club station worked in a given period, this excluding GX3ASR.

Total points: In each section the sum of the contact and bonus points for that section.

Awards

A certificate to the station with the highest score in each of the 3 sections. A certificate to the club member with the highest OVERALL score in their club. The G3GC Edgware Activity Cup to the Edgware member with the highest overall score.

Logs

There is no prescribed form for log sheets. However, it greatly helps the checking of entries if band, mode and section, together with claimed scores are clearly indicated. Also include a summary sheet for claimed scores in each section and do indicate your own club on the entry. The old RSGB paper log form is very acceptable and for electronic entries the Cabrillo log format is preferred but not essential.
